

# HOUSE CLEANING PROCEDURES

<b>1</b>	<b>Remove all muck and empty all slurry channels tanks and channels</b>
<b>2</b>	<b>Isolate the electricity supply</b>
<b>3</b>	<b>Remove all moveable equipment, feeders lamps etc, and open all inaccessible areas e.g. channels fan boxes etc</b>
<b>4</b>	<b>Brush down and sweep out the house</b>
<b>5</b>	<b>Soak the building, from roof to floor with a farm detergent or water. Leave for 24 hours if possible</b>
<b>6</b>	<b>Soak all equipment and clean down outside</b>
<b>7</b>	<b>Drain and flush out the water system, bowls, nipples, water tanks etc and fill with a detergent steriliser. Leave until disinfection is finished</b>
<b>8</b>	<b>Pressure wash the building using hot water or a steam cleaner</b>
<b>9</b>	<b>Check the building to ensure nothing has been missed</b>
<b>10</b>	<b>Disinfect the house including all equipment and surrounds using a pressure washer or spray of virucidal disinfectant</b>
<b>11</b>	<b>Follow this with fumigation using formalin gas where this is appropriate with suitable precautions</b>
<b>12</b>	<b>Place a disinfectant foot bath outside the house and use prior to entry. Drain and refill the water tanks Do not restock the house until dry (A minimum of 48 hours) If you have to occupy the house before this then use heat to dry out the surfaces</b>
